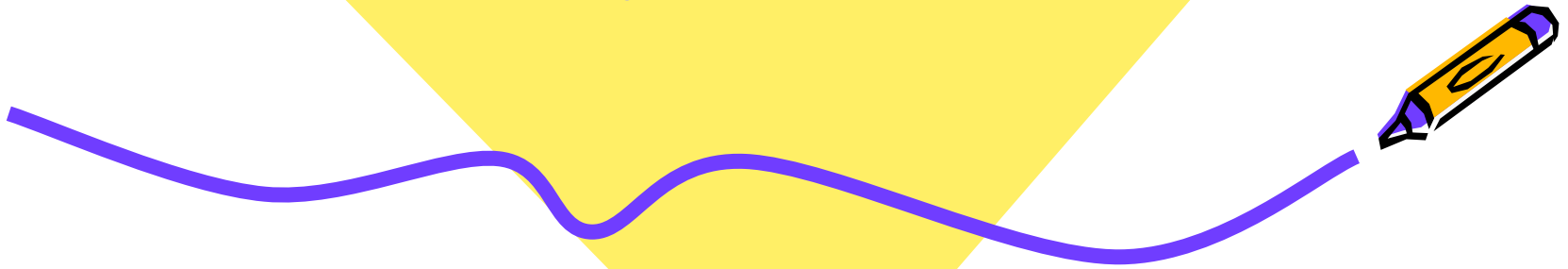


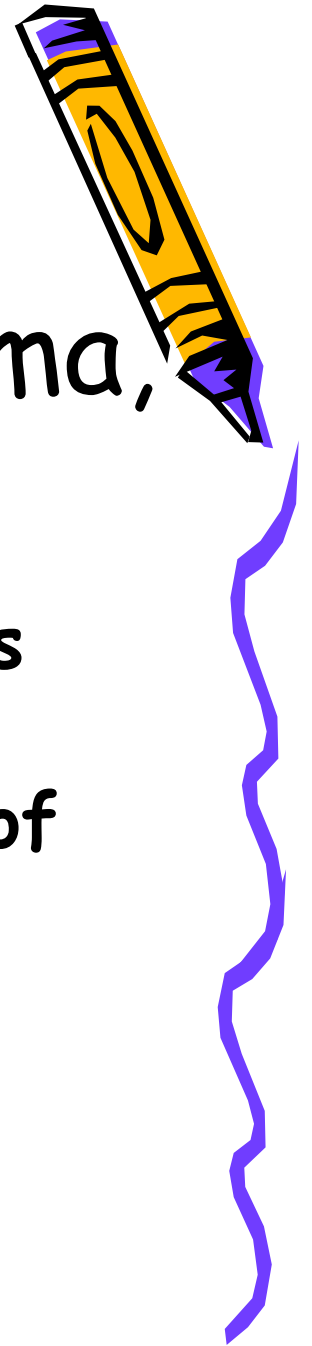

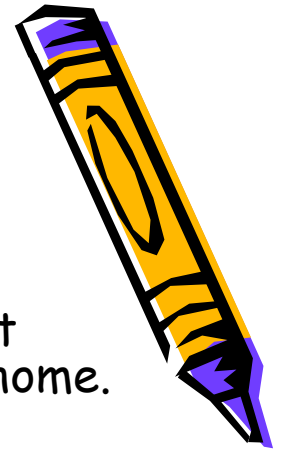
Teacher's Names Resource, MWA, New Drama, Philosophy

SAFETY

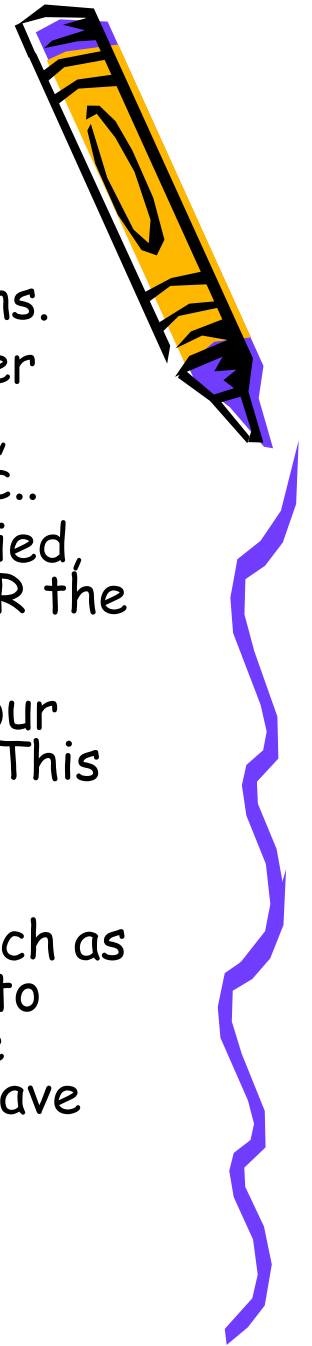


- Sign in at front office at all times. Please do not expect to come to the room to take your child home. The office will notify us by phone.
- Walkers-Please make sure you have a written note signed with your permission to walk and include what route your child will take. No walkers will be allowed over the phone unless we have this on file.
- Drills- Monthly Fire Drill, 1 lockdown, 1 evacuation each semester also 1 tornado drill
- Parent Pick up is a safety issue. We must know who is receiving the children by having an organized plan. Please do not use any other method of PPU such as the faculty parking lot, front of building or side of building. If you have an appointment or another issue as to why the PPU line will not work for you, Mrs. Kirschner will approve on a case by case basis.



SAFETY cont'd

- Clinic- Students may request the clinic for many reasons.
 1. Pass is written by teacher/ staff member
 2. Child is seen at clinic, pass is completed, temperature checked, scratch cleaned, etc..
 3. If the school feels you need to be notified, we will call you and request you to pick up your child OR the child might be sent back to class WITH a clinic pass.
 4. If you want to be notified every time your child is sent to the clinic, please let the teacher know. This information will be kept by the school.
- Please be diligent about keeping an eye on symptoms such as fever, cough, or flu like symptoms. Please do not come to school if the symptoms last longer than 24 hours. More details will be given on the first day of school. If you have ANY questions, please call us.



School Information

- Absence- If your child is absent, please call the school by 9:30. Only children with a doctor's note will be excused, unless there is a death in the family.
- Lost and Found- In the clinic. We will donate lost items at the end of each quarter.
- 7:55 announcements
- 8:00 attendance checked promptly, if your child is even one minute late, you will need to go to the office for a tardy pass.

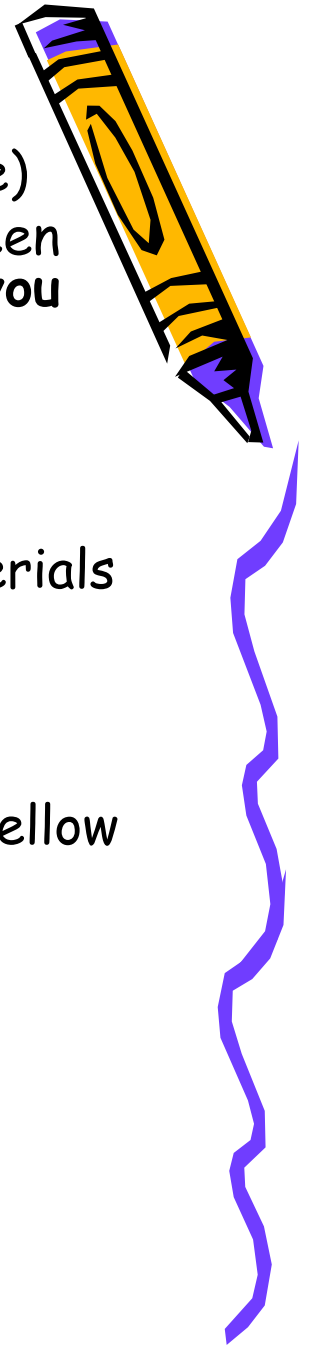


Required Materials:

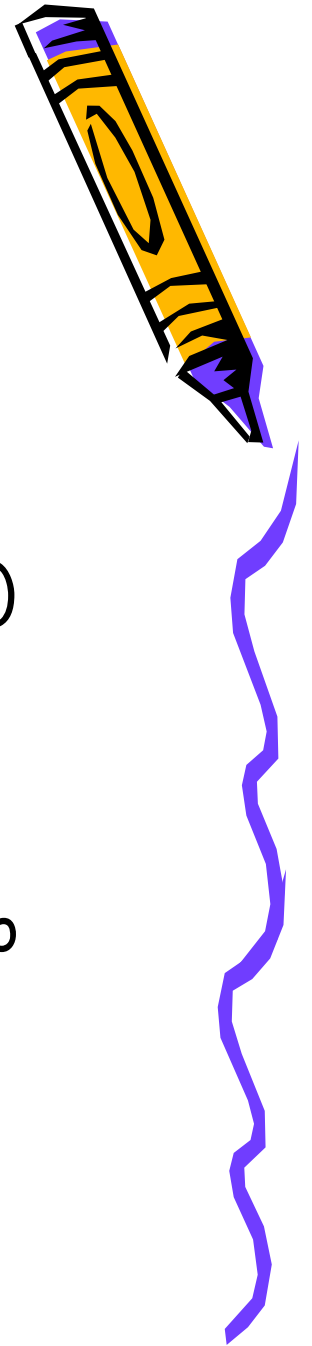
Classroom Expectations:

- Follow teacher's directions.



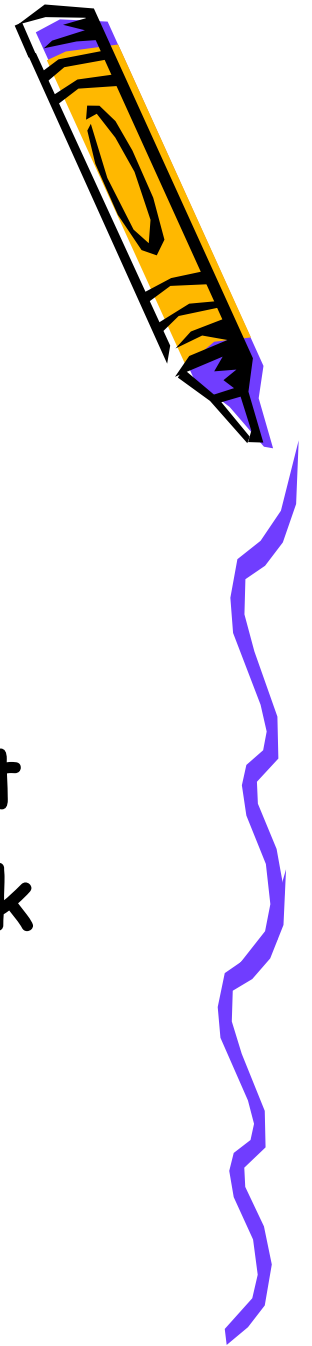
Consequences:

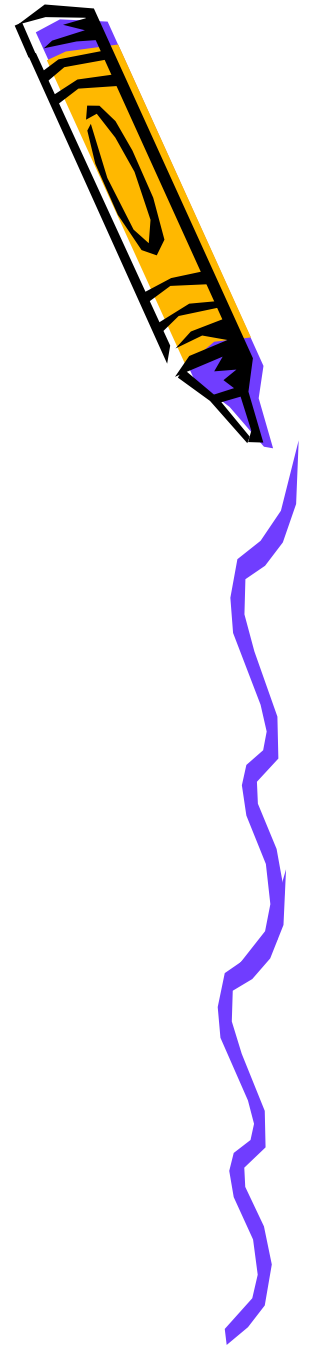

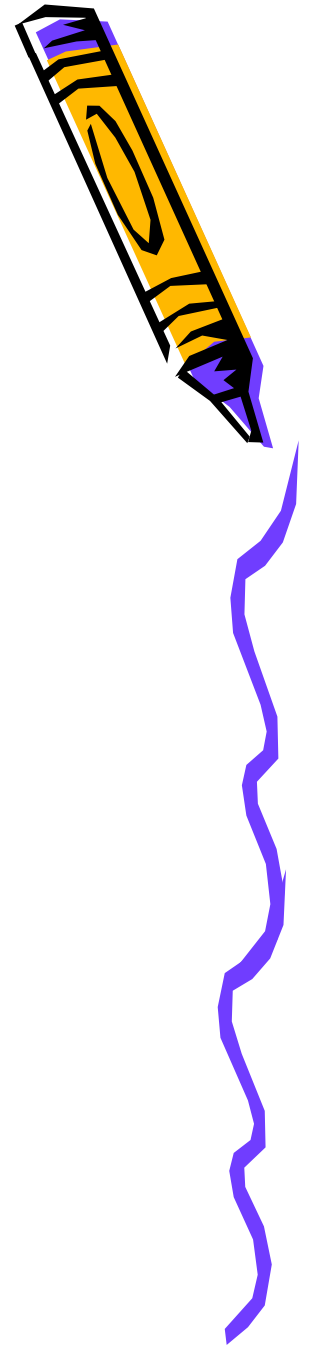

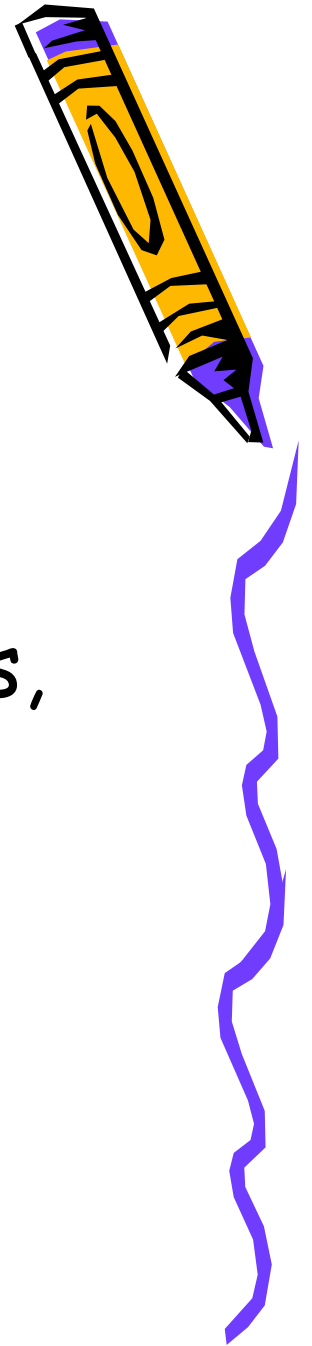




- Parentlink- You can see grades for the current quarter only. They are updated weekly on Wednesday.

 - Please go to the site and read the first page for most information, then call Edison Park and ask for Linda O'Connell for any other issues.



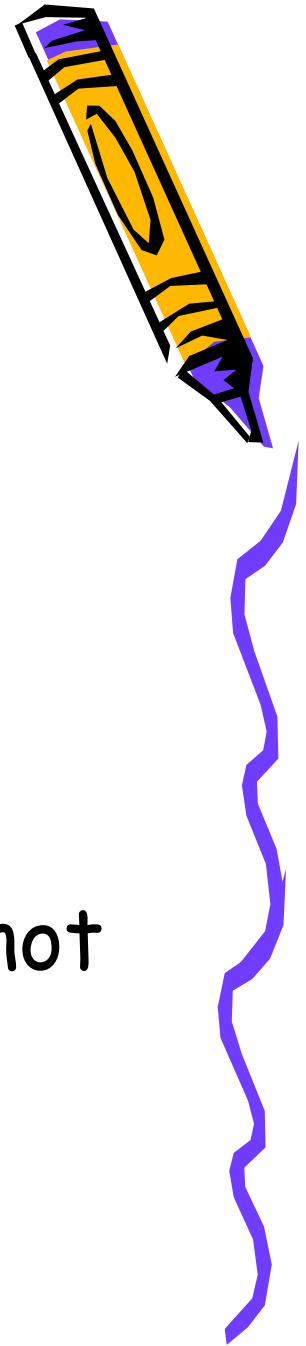
- **Science and Social Studies**

- Checking grades on Parent Link. It will be updated every Tuesday. Comments from special areas are not included.



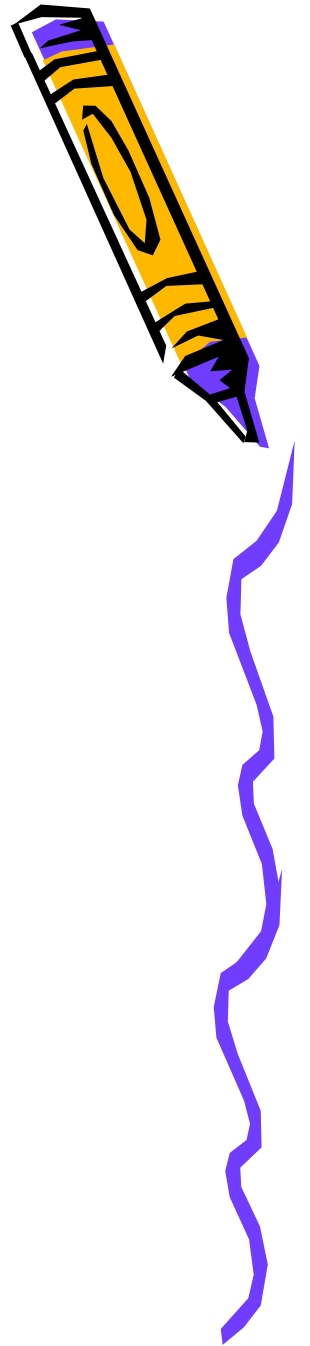
Special Areas



- Every child will attend Dance, Drama, PE, Art, Music, Guidance, Officer Joe's Safety Program, Tech and possibly extra groups or violin.

- If you need help with supplies please let us know.

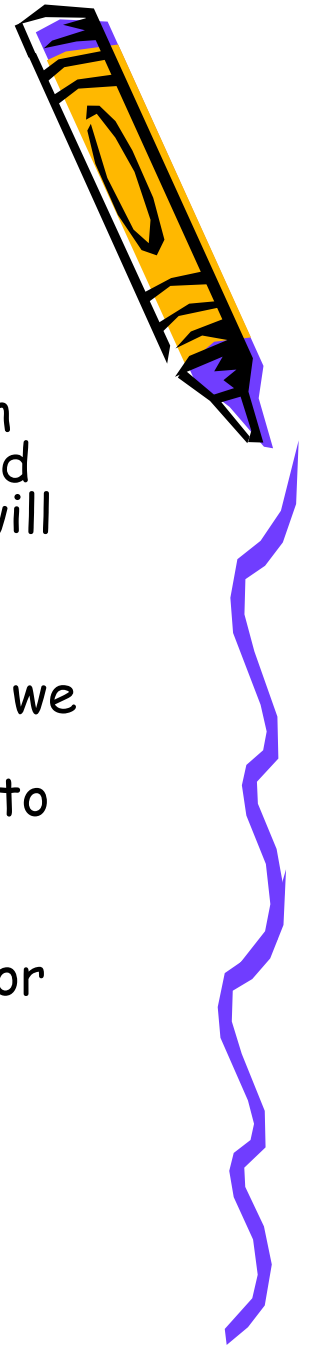

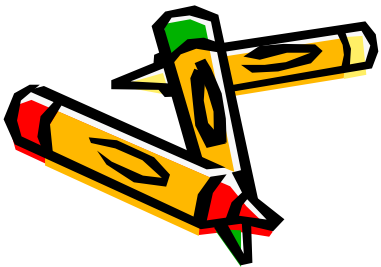
Homework Policy

- Homework within the class may vary. Our goal is to tailor homework to meet students' individual needs.

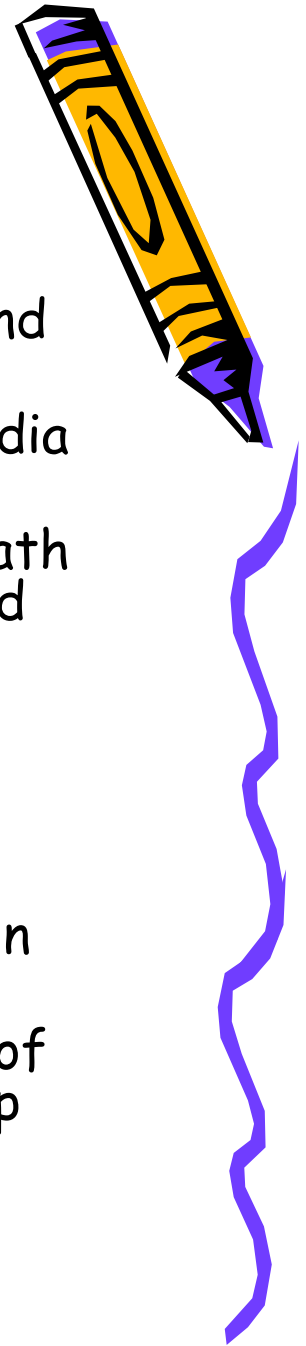


Lunch Money

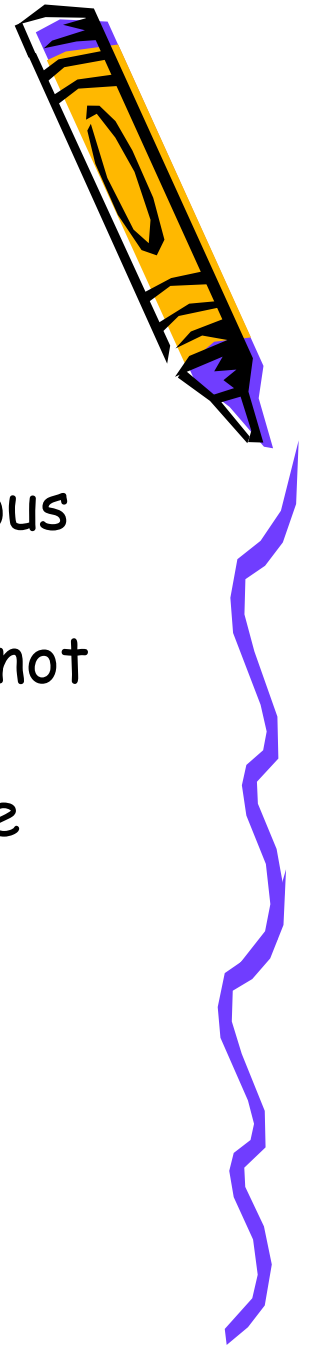


- If you are interested in volunteering please tell us what time and day would work for you.

- Please be on time for performances and please know we don't reserve seats, first come, first serve...etiquette is important. Waving, yelling, phones on....

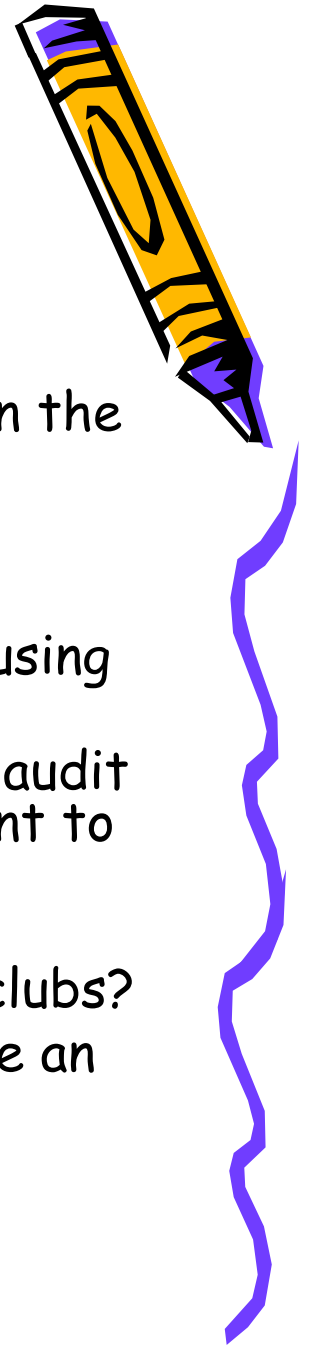
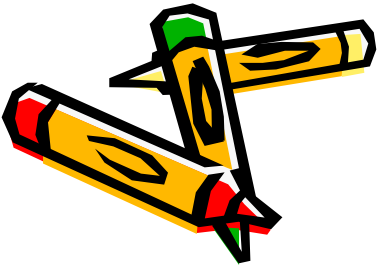

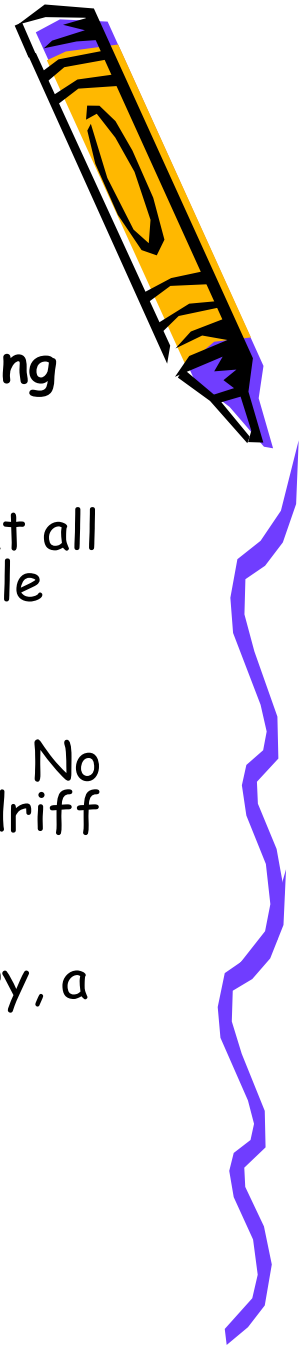
After school program

- Are you interested in sending your child to one of our clubs? Track, Chess, Nature, Spanish, Pottery, Yearbook...Have an idea, let us know.



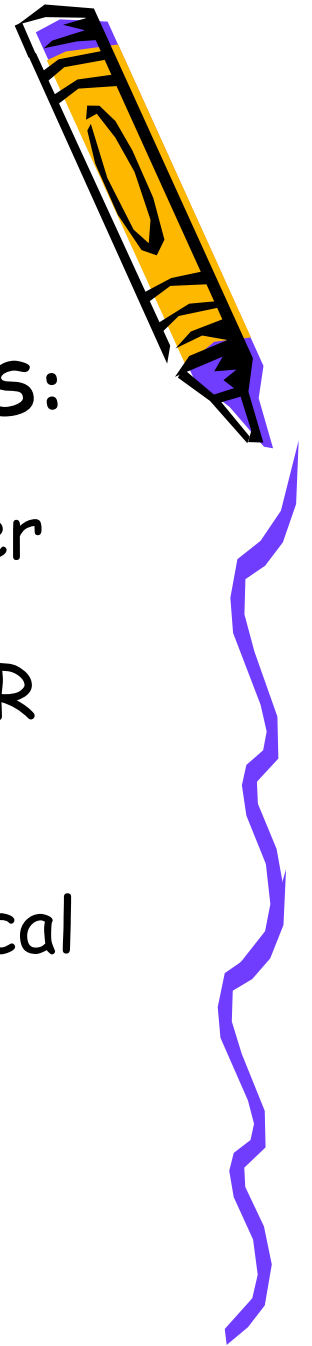
Student Dress Code

- **CONSEQUENCE:** Phone call home - parent must bring appropriate attire or clothes from the clinic will be provided
- **SHIRTS:** Boys and girls **MUST** have shirts tucked in at all times. Girls' blouses made to be worn out are acceptable as long as they are not past fingertip length.
- Long, oversized jerseys are prohibited.
- There will be no spaghetti straps or tank tops allowed. No bare midriffs (when student's hands are raised, no midriff should be exposed).
- **PANTS/SHORTS:** Pants should fit properly and be fastened at the waist with a **BELT WORN** (if necessary, a waist tie will be provided).
- Pants that are long and baggy enough to cover the student's shoes are unsafe and prohibited.

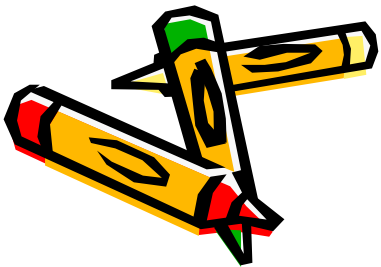


Dress Code

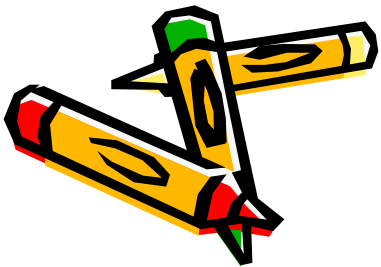
- **SHORTS/SKIRTS/JUMPERS/SKORTS:** All listed must be fingertip length or longer. Leggings are permitted; however the fingertip rule still applies.
- Dress code applies to field trips and AR celebrations.
- **SHOES:** Must be closed-toe for maximum safety. Participation in physical education requires tennis shoes. **NO CLOGS, MULES, SANDALS, CLEATS, "HEELYS", FLIP FLOPS, CROCS, platforms or heels over 1^{1/2} inches.**

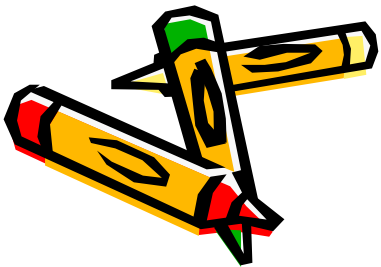
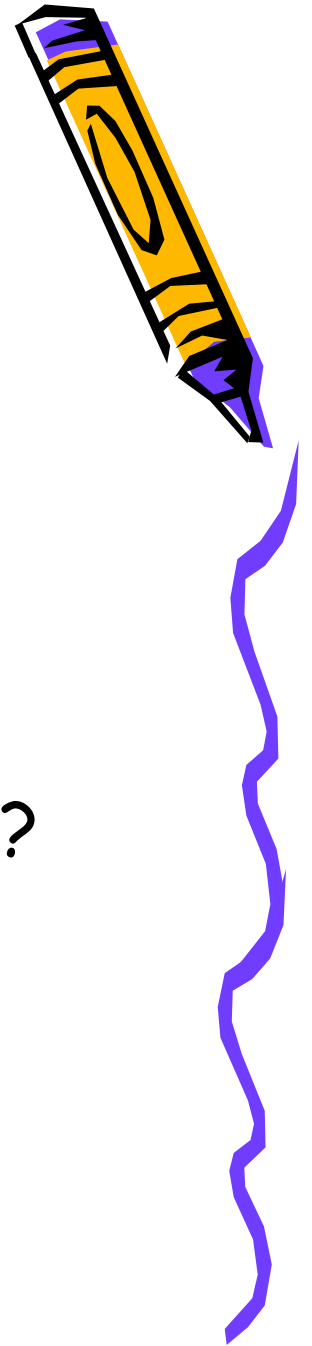
- Student Led conferences are the first and third quarters. Every parent is required to attend with their child.

Dismissal Procedures

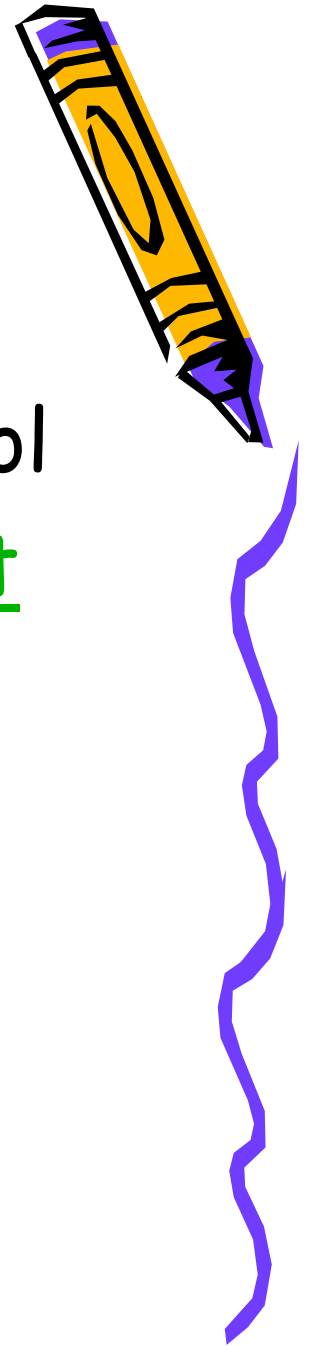
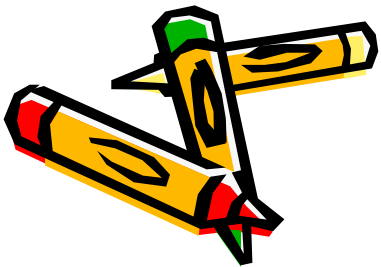
- PPU is at the back of the school. The next slide will show the process. All parents will be given 2 car tags, any extra will be sold in the school store or if they are lost. They will hang from the rear view mirror to expedite process.
- Please be at your child's bus stop 15 minutes before the pick-up time. The first day the bus might be late. 😞 Seat belts must be worn, if they are on the bus.
- At dismissal, bus riders will exit at the front door.
- Walkers will dismiss with bus riders, go to the ramp, and proceed either East or West. Parents need to have a written letter on file with the school with the route they will walk.
- Bike riders will dismiss with day care into the courtyard. Parents please be in view to meet your child, otherwise your child will not be allowed to exit. If they are riding, we need to know the route.

Students will not be allowed to walk and ride bikes ~~after~~ the initial dismissal. No walking or riding bikes home from day care. Safety would be an issue.
